


Shrinking your beanbag

1. Undressing



Unzip your cover and remove it from your inner bag. Spread the cover and then fold it flat together. Your cover will now fit back into it's transport bag.


2. Shrinking

Put your vetsak back in its original transport foil. Gather the foil together at the opening and insert the vacuum cleaner nozzle through the opening, securing the foil firmly around the nozzle. The vacuum cleaner nozzle must rest on the inner bag.

Turn on the vacuum cleaner to start shrinking your vetsak.


Caution

If the transport foil is accidentally sucked in, remove the foil from the nozzle and correct the nozzle's placement immediately, as your vacuum cleaner may overheat.




Wait until the vetsak has shrunk to about 1/3 of its original size. Your beanbag can now be placed into the original transport box.

The smaller you shrink your vetsak and the more rectangular you can shape it while vacuuming, the easier it will fit into the box.



Keeping the vacuum cleaner on and leaving the nozzle in the transport foil, place the beanbag into its transport box. We recommend that this be done with 2 people in order to make the transfer easier.

Once your vetsak is in its transport box turn off the vacuum cleaner, pull out the nozzle and close the foil quickly with tape or a strong rubber band.
